The authors are experts.

- They teach at a university and/or their educational background (e.g. PhD) is provided.

The information is based on research.

- Information is objective— based on facts, not opinions.
- The findings are based on a literature review and/or a study (e.g. methodology, data).

You know where the information came from.

- Sources are provided (e.g. bibliography, footnotes).

The intended audience is other experts.

- Complex language is used and may be difficult to understand.
- The source cannot be found at the grocery store or newsstand.
