Get Research Help

Jump start your research with our <u>subject research guides</u> and <u>course guides</u>. All online resources, including articles, <u>e-books</u> and videos, continue to be available and accessible through our <u>research databases</u> and the <u>library catalog</u>. You can also check the Library's <u>Freely Available and Library Resources webpage</u>. Still can't find what you need? Submit an <u>ILL request</u>, including the chapters you need access to, if applicable.

Librarians are also available to help you with your research needs via live chat.

Find Textbooks and Course Materials
